Where the University is required to add VAT, GST or any other sales tax at the local statutory rate, this will be added to the fees shown during the payment process. For students residing in the UK, our fees are exempt from VAT.

Programme Fees are per module and are paid at initial or continuing registration. You are encouraged to complete within two years, (first year: two core modules and dissertation part 1; second year: four elective modules and dissertation part 2), but you can take up to five years to complete the programme and pay per module when you register. Fees may be paid in one of the following ways.

Either

1. A single payment, covering all module fees for the MA degree;

Or

2. The fee for modules to be studied in the first year. To be registered, you must pay the fee for at least one module. In subsequent years, only the fees for any new modules or the dissertation (parts 1 and 2), as applicable, are payable. If you want to pay for modules as you progress through your studies, the following deadlines apply:
